

MINUTES OF MEETING

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Trail of the Lakes Municipal Utility District (the "District") met in special session, open to the public, at 2:30 p.m., on Friday, July 17, 2026, at 9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046, a designated meeting place outside the boundaries of the District; whereupon, the roll was called of the members of the Board of Directors, to- wit:

All members of the Board of Directors were present, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present at the meeting were: Estella Aguilar, Jaelin Hidalgo, and Veronica Guardiola, residents of the District; Sergeant Romero of the Harris County Constable's Office, Precinct No. 4 (the "Constable"); and Hicham Chiali, attorney, and Shaila Sreedharan, paralegal, of Coats Rose, P.C. ("Coats Rose"), legal counsel for the District.

Whereupon, the meeting was called to order in accordance with the posted notice. A copy of the posted notice is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Board recognized the residents of the District who discussed their concerns with the security, the Constables, and the Directors. Mr. Chiali, Sergeant Romero, and the Directors responded to the comments.

DISCUSS SECURITY OPTIONS FOR RENEWAL OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES ("AGREEMENT") AND TAKE ANY ACTION REQUIRED

The Board and Sergeant Romero discussed the renewal of the Agreement and the Deputy options. Sergeant Romero reported that the District currently has eight deputies patrolling in the District 70% of working contract time. The Board discussed the desired level of law enforcement patrol services within the District, including the number of deputies, the percentage of patrol time to be dedicated to the District, and the associated costs. Director King moved to approve the renewal of the Agreement providing for eight deputies with a 65%/35% patrol allocation. Director Cooper seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

There being no other business to come before the Board, and a motion duly made and seconded, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting.
