Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A. Government Code, Chapter 551 that the Board of Directors of Trail of the Lakes Municipal Utility District will meet in regular session, open to the public, at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, April 27, 2026, at 9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046, a designated location outside the Boundaries of the District. 1. Consideration of Public Comments.*
2. Consideration of comments from the Property Owners Association/Homeowners Association representatives.*
3. Approve minutes from the meeting of March 23, 2026.
4. Hear Security Report and consider taking action thereon.
5. Hear Financial Advisor's Report and consider taking any action thereon, including:
 - a. Review bids and consider awarding the sale of the District's Unlimited Tax Park Bonds, Series 2026 (the "Bonds");
 - b. Approve and authorize execution of the following in connection with the issuance of each of the Bonds, including:
 - i. Order Authorizing Issuance of Bonds;
 - ii. Order Approving Official Statement;
 - iii. General Certificate;
 - iv. Signature Identification and No-Litigation Certificate;
 - v. Letters addressed to Attorney General of Texas and Coats Rose, P.C. regarding dating of the Signature ID and No-Litigation Certificate and the General Certificate and Letter to the Comptroller regarding delivery of Initial Bonds;
 - vi. Initial Bonds;
 - vii. Tax Exemption Certificate;
 - viii. Bond Registrar, Paying Agent and Transfer Agency Agreement;
 - ix. Rule 15c2-12 Certificate;
 - x. IRS Form 8038-G; and
 - c. Take such other actions and execute other documents and certificates necessary to obtain approval of the Bonds by the Attorney General.
6. Hear Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. authorize payment of bills from the tax account; and
 - b. review Delinquent Tax Attorney's Report.
7. Hear District Communications Report and consider taking action thereon.
8. Hear Solid Waste and Recycling Report and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. consider proposal for 65-gallon recycling carts for the residents.
9. Hear Bookkeeper's Report, and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. review investments; and
 - b. approve payment of bills and issuance of checks.
10. Hear Operator's Report, and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. authorization of termination of water and sewer service to delinquent accounts;
 - b. discuss status of aeration tank repairs and consider taking necessary action;
 - c. authorize Operator to make necessary repairs to water and sanitary sewer system;
 - d. status of miscellaneous operational and customer matters; and
 - e. approve and authorize distribution of the District's 2026 Drinking Water Quality Report (Consumer Confidence Report).

11. Hear Engineer's Report, and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. review and approve pay estimates and change orders to construction contracts, as needed;
 - b. review new service requests/applications;
 - c. review Water Well No. 4 assessment and rehabilitation;
 - d. status of repair to Williams Gully Channel P130-02-00;
 - e. status of Rankin Road right-of-way modifications;
 - f. consider authorizing Engineer and Attorney to solicit bids for landscaping and detention pond services and take any action necessary; and
 - g. status of preparation of Bond Application Report ("BAR") No. 17.
12. Hear Double Oak Maintenance Report and consider taking action thereon.
13. Hear Transcend Groundworks Report and consider taking action thereon.
14. Hear District Recreational Facilities Management Report and update on development of recreational facilities, and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. status of improvement, repair, and maintenance projects;
 - b. capital park projects design and preliminary work;
 - c. discuss 2026 National Night Out; and
 - d. discuss holiday events at dog park.
15. Hear Attorney's Report and consider taking action thereon, including:
 - a. discuss and consider requests for insurance proposals; and
 - b. ratify approval of contract with EVO.

Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended, the Board of Directors may convene in closed session to receive advice from legal counsel and discuss matters relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, gifts and donations, security devices and/or economic development negotiations. 
**The Board of Directors has adopted a public comment policy and has limited public comments to three minutes for each commenter or five minutes per subject, whichever is less.*
